### ***2) South Zone Sports Tournaments***

In the recent SZ Tournaments for basketball, floorball, soccer and volleyball, our pupils did the school proud by putting in their best efforts for the tournaments that they played. They had gained much experience and definitely honed their skills in the various sports. It was indeed heartening to see them improve in their performance in the competitions this year!

It is also with great pride that we announce that after so many years of hard work put in, both our junior and senior volleyball girls obtained 4th position in the South Zone Primary Schools Volleyball Championships 2016. They will be participating in the National Primary Schools Volleyball Championships 2016 for the first time this year! We would like to wish them the very best in their coming championships!

### ***3) Junior Brigadier Brooch Award***

Two of our GB girls, Wong Xue En, Cheyenne of P6 Graciousness and Teow Yong Han of P6 Integrity, have been awarded the Junior Brigadier Brooch, the highest national award a primary girl can achieve in the Girls' Brigade. These girls have achieved the following:

- a) Attained the Junior Star Award
- b) Displayed integrity, have good report and be above reproach
- c) Demonstrated the ability to plan and execute tasks; exercise initiative and able to lead others
- d) Shown the capacity of looking after the well-being of her team

### ***4) The Boys' Brigade Best Boy Award***

Sng Yun Liang, David of P6 Graciousness was nominated as the Best Boy in the BB unit of Zhangde Primary School and has successfully been awarded the Tan Boon Chiang medal. This medal is named after the BB's Honorary President (Retired), Mr Tan Boon Chiang, PPA, BBM (L) and was instituted in 2003 to recognise the top Boy in each BB Company in Primary Schools. Well done, David!

### **5) *Selection Trial for Revised Junior Sports Academy (JSA) Programme 2016***

Children should explore, discover and develop their areas of interest and strengths across a wide range of different domains. In line with MOE's efforts to provide broad-based opportunities for children do so, the Junior Sports Academy (JSA) programme was revised in 2015. The revisions are as follows:

Budding sporting talents will be identified and developed with a broad-based physical sports programme, to strengthen their overall physical competencies and motivation in sports at the primary school level. These children will explore and discover their strength and passion in a range of sports at the primary school level, and subsequently to make an informed choice to commit to one of them with more targeted support from schools and relevant sports organisations at the secondary school level and beyond. The trial will evaluate the child's general physical ability. There will not be any test on sport-specific skills. Instead, the child's natural ability of agility, balance, coordination, speed and power will be evaluated. There is no need to train or prepare for the trial. Sufficient time will be given during the trial for children to familiarise themselves with the items used in the evaluation.

Selected P4 students will participate in a two-year programme (from Primary 4 Semester 2 to Primary 6 Semester 1). They will choose four sports modules to participate in. Each sports module is conducted once a week over one semester, followed up with sports-related workshops at the end of the module. Selected P5 students may participate in a one-year programme and choose 2 sports modules (from Primary 5 Semester 2 to Primary 6 Semester 1). The programme will be conducted mostly at 10 JSA centres hosted in schools near MRT stations and spread across Singapore to facilitate easy access. At the end of the JSA programme, students will have a stronger sports foundation. They will be more aware of their sporting strengths, interests and sports more suited for them.

The selection trial will be conducted on Saturday, 26th March, at the Singapore Sports Hub (OCBC Arena). Nomination for the selection trial will be done through schools. ### **6) *Upcoming March School Holidays***

As past experience has shown that we should be well-prepared for the risk of a pandemic flu, we would like to seek your continual support in safe-guarding the well-being of our pupils and staff, should there be a potential health threat regionally or globally. In this regard, in view of the upcoming March school holidays, please monitor the well-being of your child/ward and bring him/her to see a doctor if he/she is unwell with flu-like symptoms or has returned from a country with a history of flu outbreak. We hope to work together with you to continue to educate our pupils to be socially responsible, and help to keep our school safe.

### **7) *Nation-wide Fight Against Dengue (Stay Alert. Fight Dengue.)***

The number of dengue cases in 2016 has increased considerably with more cases being reported. Immediate measures need to be taken to reduce the Aedes mosquito population. The same Aedes mosquito also transmits the Zika virus, and with the threat of Zika infection looming, it is critical to reduce the mosquito population. Prevention of mosquito breeding and vector control remain the mainstay to prevent transmission of both viruses.

The National Environment Agency has launched the annual 'Do the Mozzie Wipeout' Campaign 2016 on Sunday, 28 February 2016, ahead of the traditional dengue peak season. The campaign calls for the community to take appropriate precautions to prevent mosquito breeding by practising the 5-step Mozzie Wipeout in their homes and premises. Starting from 28 February, a concerted effort by all over a 14-day period will address two rounds of mosquito breeding cycle, and this will make a collective impact towards suppressing the population. You and your family are invited to join in the fight against Dengue/Zika by doing the below 5-step Mozzie Wipeout in your homes and keep it mosquito-free.

1. Turn the pail
2. Flip the flower pot plate
3. Tip the vase
4. Cap the bamboo pole holder
5. Clear the gutter

#### **8) Annual Health Check**

The School Health Service will be visiting the school from Monday, 21<sup>st</sup> March to Friday, 1<sup>st</sup> April to conduct the annual health screening exercise. During the visit, the health team will need all relevant past and current medical information about your child and your consent for immunisation (for P1 and P5 pupils only). Form teachers have started collecting the health booklets as well as any medical and immunisation records from all pupils.

Parents of P1 and P5 pupils would have received an information booklet on the School Health Service. In the booklet, there is a form where parents need to provide information on their child's past medical history and information on allergies. Immunisation will be scheduled for the P1 and P5 pupils. Parents with children in these levels will need to sign the consent forms attached in the information booklet. Please return both forms (for P1 &

P5 pupils only) and submit the health booklets to your child's form teacher by **latest Wednesday, 9<sup>th</sup> March**.

#### **9) Classes for P6 pupils during the March school holidays**

During the March holidays, the school will be organising classes and curriculum-related learning journeys for our P6 pupils. They will be conducted on Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> March till Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> March from 8 am – 12 pm. Do ensure that your child attends all the classes. All absences must be covered by either a letter or medical certificate.

#### **10) NLB Bulk Borrowing**

Zhangde Primary School has been collaborating with Bukit Merah Public Library for the NLB Bulk Borrowing program over the last few years. We had a very successful exercise in Term 1 and will be conducting our next bulk borrowing for the year in Term 2 on Monday, 28<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, 29<sup>th</sup> March. During bulk borrowing, the teachers will be bringing the pupils to the either the library or ISH Band Room to borrow the books during designated curriculum periods.

The school would like to seek the assistance of all parents to ensure that your child / ward has the opportunity to borrow books during this period by doing the following:

- Pay the fines (if applicable) in your child's / ward's record at any of the library branches.
- If your child / ward has lost his / her school Ezlink card before, do report the loss at any of the library branches and make a separate library card.
- Ensure your child / ward has his/her school Ezlink card on that day.

To be able to borrow 8 books on the day of mass borrowing, all books under your child's / ward's records have to be returned at any of the public library branches before the onsite borrowing event.

For books borrowed on the NLB Bulk Borrowing day, all parents are to ensure that the books borrowed are returned at any of the public library branches by the due date, which will be indicated, on the borrowing receipt.
