The heart, with its four shades of red, represents the diversity of Singapore and our various races and religions living together in harmony. It celebrates this diversity and harmony, and reflects our love for Singapore, where we are happy and proud to call home. In brush stroke, the number "51" marks our nation's 51st birthday and the first chapter of our next 50 years towards SG100. The handwritten font represents our future, which is ours to write and build together. The upward brushstroke of the number "6" demonstrates that Singapore is forward-looking, always striving to reach even greater heights. The tip of the "6" bursting into a firework of five stars depicts the nation's ideals as represented in our national flag. The NDP 2016 logo was created by 19 year-old Chelsea Lim, a Singapore Polytechnic student pursuing a Diploma in Visual Communications and Media Design.

The theme for this year's National Day Parade (NDP) is "**Building our Singapore of Tomorrow**". "Building" implies that nation-building is a conscientious endeavour and that the journey towards our future can be realised with hard work. "*Our Singapore*" invokes in Singaporeans a sense of belonging and rootedness to the country and our future. "*Tomorrow*" is forward looking and connotes the start of the next chapter post SG50. 2) National Day Celebrations

On Monday, 8th August, we will be celebrating Singapore's 51st Birthday. On that day, all pupils will report to school as usual at 7.30 am in red and white and the school will be dismissed at 10 am. Do enjoy the holiday break celebrating our country's 51st birthday with your children. School will resume on Thursday, 11th August.

3) PSLE Oral Examinations

The PSLE English and Mother Tongue Oral Examination for P6 pupils will be held on 18th and 19th August. P6 pupils will be given separate instructions on their reporting time.

All P1 to P5 pupils need **not** report to school. Instead, there will be home-based learning for the pupils on these two days.

4) Gifted Education Programme Screening Test

The Gifted Education Branch of the Curriculum Planning & Development Division will be carrying out the identification of pupils for the Gifted Education Programme (GEP) 2017. The identification exercise is carried out in two stages – Screening and Selection. The GEP Screening Test will be conducted on Friday, 26th August in the school. Shortlisted pupils at the Screening Stage will be invited to the Selection Stage which will be held on 18 October and 19 October 2016. The test is open to all Primary 3 pupils only. A separate letter has been issued to all P3 parents. Parents are to respond by Friday, 12th August if you would like your child to sit for the GEP Screening Test. Reply slips are to be returned back to their respective form teachers. We would like to encourage you to allow your child to sit for the Screening Test.

5) Edusave Character Award (ECHA)

Edusave Character Award (ECHA) is given out to recognise pupils who demonstrate exemplary character and outstanding personal qualities through their behaviour and actions. This is part of the larger goal to foster an inclusive and stronger Singapore as we broaden the qualities and achievements to be encouraged and applauded.

Pupils must satisfy the following criteria to be eligible for the award:

- i. Pupil must be a Singaporean;
- ii. Pupil must demonstrate the GIVER³S values (at least 3 values) on a consistent basis;
- iii. Pupil is concerned about environmental or community issues as a demonstration of civic responsibility; and/or
- iv. Pupil demonstrates resilience in the face of difficult circumstances and managed to overcome the odds and still do commendably well in academic and non-academic domains.

Nominations will be open from Monday, 1 August to Friday, 19 August. Nominations can be submitted by pupils, school staff and/or parents. The nomination forms are available at the General Office and can also be downloaded from our school website. We encourage parents to put in your nominations for any deserving pupils you know of.

The ECHA award recipients will receive a certificate and an award voucher. The award quantum is as follows, depending on the level of study:

Levels	Award Quantum
Primary 1 to 3	\$200
Primary 4 to 6	\$350
