Important Announcements...

8) *School Matters – 2018*

All students must report to the school hall in the morning at 7.30 a.m. sharp daily. We seek the cooperation of all parents to help us to instil in our students the value of **punctuality**. All students are encouraged to arrive in school at least 5 minutes before the reporting time to give themselves time to settle in and get ready for the day.

To promote the well-being of our students and allow students to enjoy the benefits of being able to eat regularly during formal curriculum time, as well as to ensure that students taking school bus or public transport, who may take time to reach home do not go hungry for an extended period of time, a 10-minute snack break has been introduced during the formal curriculum time to allow students to eat regularly from 2017. Students are advised to bring a snack to school daily as they will not be allowed to buy snacks from the canteen during the snack break. Simple snack items to be brought for the snack break should be in line with the Healthy Meals in Schools Programme:

- Recommended simple snack items include bread, biscuits, muffins, cereal bars, dried cereal without milk, fresh / dried fruits and plain water
- Unhealthy snack items such as ice-cream, chocolate, sweets, chips and sweet drinks are **NOT allowed**.

To ensure hygiene and cleanliness in classes, students will empty the snack wrappers and waste at the waste paper baskets provided in the classrooms.

The school hours will be from 7.30 a.m. to 1.45 p.m. from Monday to Friday. The general office will close at 6 p.m. daily while the school gate will be locked at 7 p.m. to cater to the needs of students who attend the student care till 6.30 p.m. The recess timings are as follows:

Parents / guardians are strongly urged to remind their children / ward to bring their learning materials, homework assignments and sufficient pocket money to school each day. We would like to inculcate in our students the school value of responsibility.

9) Birthday Celebrations

We will not facilitate any request for birthday celebrations including distribution of goodie bags in school in view of the feelings of all other students, their dietary needs and possible allergic reactions. We seek your understanding and co-operation in this.

10) Safety and Security

As part of the school's efforts to maintain a safe environment for all our students, MOE has provided schools with 2 NSRS trained security guards since May 2005. During curriculum time, for parents or guardians who wish to come to school, you would need to report to the security post for signing in and collect both a visitor's pass and a sticker for identification. You would then need to go to the reception counter at the general office where our receptionist will assist you. Parent volunteers coming into the school will also need to put on their tags. We seek your co-operation to put on these passes at all times when you are in the school and to return them at the security counter upon leaving the school.

11) School Carpark

We would like to seek the cooperation of all parents to exercise courtesy and consideration by not holding up traffic especially during peak hours. The school carpark is reserved for the use of the school staff and school buses. On Fridays, in particular, we do have instructors and coaches who come to the school to conduct our CCA with the students and they need the car park lots. Visitors and parents on official business may park their vehicles at the vacant carpark lots. Parents waiting to fetch their children home are advised to park their cars at the nearby HDB carparks.

For parents and guardians who have prepared packed lunches for their children during the afternoons when they have after-school activities, do take note that your children will collect their lunches from you at the area in front of the Heritage Corner.

No parents and guardians are allowed into the school during curriculum time and lunchtime.

All these measures are taken to ensure that we do not compromise on the safety of our children. We seek your fullest cooperation on this.

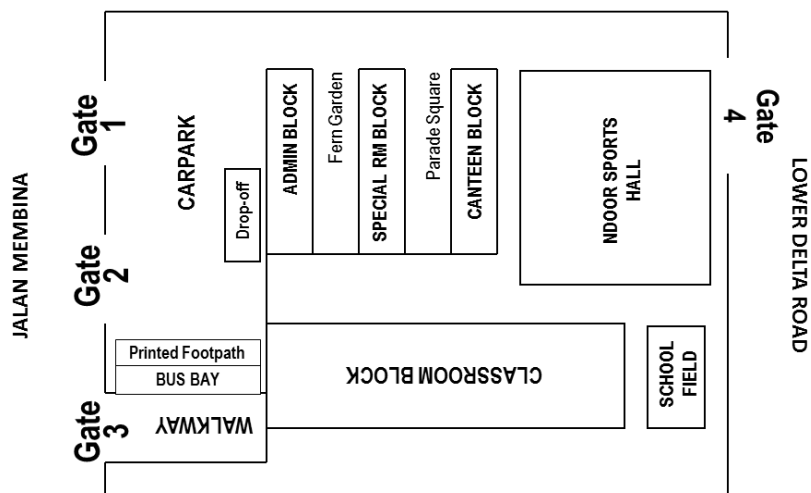
12) Opening Hours of School Gates

Gate 1 (Main gate beside bin centre)	6.30 a.m. – 7.45 a.m.
Gate 2 (Main gate near foyer)	6.30 a.m. – 1.00 p.m. 2.00 p.m. – 7.00 p.m.
Gate 3 (Side gate for pedestrians)	6.30 a.m. – 7.30 a.m. 1.30 p.m. – 2.15 p.m. 3.30 p.m. – 4.45 p.m.
Gate 4 (Rear gate along Lower Delta Road)	6.45 a.m. – 7.30 a.m. 1.30 p.m. – 2.15 p.m.

Please advise your child where exactly you will be fetching him/her from daily.

On rainy days, school buses will have the priority to park at the porch area. Drivers are advised to drive into the school only after the buses have left.

Gates 1 and 2 are for vehicles ONLY. Students and parents walking to school are advised to enter the school through Gate 3 for safety reasons. Beyond the stipulated gates opening hours, students and parents are advised to follow the printed footpath along the bus bay to exit from Gate 2.



Drawing reference to the media advisory released by NEA on 19 November 2014, to safeguard the public health for our Students and our staff, parents are reminded to switch off your engines while waiting to pick your children from the school.

13) Safety of your child at School Zone

As you approach the school along Jalan Membina, you would have noticed the red-textured surface and “SCHOOL” markings on the road outside our school. There are also traffic lights installed just outside the school. These road safety measures are part of the School Zone Scheme implemented by the Land Transport Authority (LTA) to improve road safety for all primary schools. This scheme highlights to motorists that they are approaching a primary school and should therefore take extra care, slow down, and be alert to look out for school children crossing the road. As you may encounter heavy traffic during school days especially between 7.15 am to 7.30 am as well as during dismissal times in the afternoon, we seek your understanding to exercise patience when you bring or fetch your child to and from school.

If you drive your child to school, please drop off your child and allow him / her to walk towards the school lobby by himself / herself so as not to hold up the traffic at the drop off point. Do avoid parking in the school as they are reserved for our staff only.

If you walk your child to school, please set a good example by crossing the road at the traffic lights located outside the school and enter via Gate 3.

LTA has implemented the road safety measures to safeguard the safety of school children. However, it requires your cooperation to make them work effectively. The public road is a shared space for all road users; let us be more gracious and considerate the next time we are in a school zone. 14) 2018 After-School Activities Structure

To keep you informed of the after-school activities of your child, please refer to Annex 2 for the 2018 After-School Activities Structure. For all school-organised activities that are conducted beyond school hours or out of school, your child will be given a consent form to be signed by you and returned before the start of any school activity. Likewise, you will also be informed through a cancellation form should any school event or activity be cancelled.

15) Whole School Approach to Reading

To promote a reading culture among our Students, they are to bring an English and a MT story book daily where they will spend the pre-assembly timeslot from 7.30 a.m. – 7.40 a.m. reading. In addition, there will be designated library periods during curriculum time. The school is collaborating with Bukit Merah Community Library on mounting various library activities in the school. We do seek your assistance in helping to inculcate the reading habit early in your child.

16) Health Matters

A child's learning is a process of acquisition of skills and knowledge. In order for our Students to gain confidence in their literacy, numeracy and scientific literacy, their presence at all lessons is of utmost importance. Thus, we seek your help in ensuring that your child is punctual for class and attends school regularly.

If your child is not feeling well, please bring him/her to see a doctor and only allow your child to return to school when he/she is feeling better. Please support your child's absence with either a medical certificate from a doctor or a letter of excuse from you.

If your child is down with chicken pox, H1N1, Hand-Foot-Mouth disease or any contagious diseases, please take your doctor's advice and let your child rest at home. As these diseases are highly infectious, we require parents to bring their child to see a doctor again to certify that he/she is fit for school before he/she is allowed to return to class. A memo from the doctor will be required. We seek your understanding in this matter as the health of our Students is our concern.

17) Temperature Taking Exercise

The 1st temperature-taking exercise has been conducted on **Friday, 5 January** in the school. We would like to seek your assistance in ensuring that your child brings his/her personal oral digital thermometer (ODT) **daily**. For students who have lost or misplaced their ODTs, or have unserviceable ODTs, please purchase a replacement available in most of the pharmacies and supermarkets. Alternatively, the ODTs can also be purchased at the school bookshop at \$4.00 each.

18) Basic Student Protection Plan 2018

As part of our dedication to student welfare, we have taken an annual basic student protection plan with NTUC Income to cover all students in the event of any injury incurred during school activities. The period of the policy coverage is from 2nd January to 31st December 2018. Do approach any of our office staff if you need assistance with the following:

- Submitting report to make a claim,
- Type of documents required when making a claim,
- Methods of submitting claims; and
- Amount of the reimbursements related to expenditures incurred.

19) Photographs/Images of Pupil for Informational and Developmental Purposes/ Non-Commercial Use

Photographs or images that include your child/ward may be used in publicity materials, presentations, website or other related materials of the school. It may be in any format such as print, electronic, video, web or other media for documentation, informational and developmental purposes or non-commercial use. Please write to the school if you do not wish the photographs or images that include your child/ward to be used.

20) Student Smart Card for P1 Students

Transit Link Pte Ltd will be making the School Smart Cards of Primary One (1) students in batches and students are expected to receive the card by April 2018.

For your information, children under 7 years old can travel for free on the public transport network with a Child Concession Card (CCD). The CCD will expire on 30th April of the year that the child turns 7 years old.

For P1 students who do not have the CCD and require one in the interim, you may wish to apply for a CCD at any Transit Link Ticket Office. You can get more info on the CCD in Transit Link's Website at <https://www.transitlink.com.sg/PSdetail.aspx?ty=art&Id=50>.

21) School Dental Clinic

Our dental therapist is Mdm Jubell Tee and she will be at the school's dental clinic from Mondays – Fridays from 8 am – 12.30 pm, starting 2nd January 2018. The direct line to the clinic is 62757392.

For parents who have not yet given the online consent for dental treatment, do look up the HPB website, <https://childconsent.hpb.gov.sg> and assist us so that your child can go for regular dental treatment at the school's dental clinic.
