- If your child receives the HRW, parents must ensure that your child performs ART test every day after 6pm on the day before the child returns to school. The child can only return to school if the ART result is negative and these results must be submitted to the Form Teacher for the entire duration of the HRW on school going days.
- Keep your child/ward who is unwell at home and seek medical attention where applicable.
