1. **Absence:** Students who are absent on the day of the examination will need to submit a medical certificate.

2. **Punctuality:** Students must be punctual for all examinations. Punctuality is a value that the school has been working very hard to inculcate in our students.

3. **EL / FEL / MT / FMT Oral Examination (see page 1 of this letter)**

Please make the necessary transport arrangements to fetch your child(ren) after their Oral Examinations on Tuesday, 16 July 2024.

4. **Use of Calculators and Mathematical Instruments for Mathematics and Foundation Mathematics**

All students are to bring the following:

- a) mathematical instruments
- b) approved scientific calculators, marked with the school sticker, are allowed to be used for Paper 2

Students will **not be allowed** to borrow any stationery or calculator from their classmates during the examination.

5. **Use of Dictionaries for Higher Mother Tongue / Mother Tongue Languages Paper 1 (Composition)**

School approved dictionaries or electronic dictionaries, marked with school sticker or stamp, are allowed to be used for the following Composition Papers:

- Chinese Language Paper 1 and Higher Chinese Language Paper 1
- Malay Language Paper 1 and Higher Malay Language Paper 1
- Tamil Language Paper 1 and Higher Tamil Language Paper 1

Please note that pictorial dictionaries / bilingual dictionaries / earpieces for e-Dictionaries are **not** allowed during the examinations.

6. **Topics tested:** Please be reminded that all topics taught from P3-P6 for Mathematics and Science will be tested for P6 Preliminary Examination as well as PSLE.

7. Students are discouraged from bringing handphones. If they do, it must be switched off and kept in their bags at all times. **Handphones** and **smart watches** are strictly **not allowed** in examination rooms.

8. **No Remedial Lessons for All Levels**

There will be **no** English Language, Mathematics, Mother Tongue Languages or Science Remedial lessons from **12 August to 29 August 2024**.
