### National Day 2017



August is always tied to our country's National Day. The logo features four hands clasped and interlocked with each other in unity. The logo is inspired by the iconic image of Singapore's first ten dollar Orchid series note launched in 1967. The intertwined hands symbolise Singaporeans from all walks of life setting aside their differences, and coming together with the conviction of building a better Singapore of tomorrow. It also reflects the important role that racial harmony has played in our 52 years of nation building.

Red is the primary colour of the logo, reflecting our celebratory mood as we commemorate Singapore's 52<sup>nd</sup> year of independence. #### 6) National Day Celebrations

On Tuesday, 8<sup>th</sup> August, we will be celebrating Singapore's 52<sup>nd</sup> Birthday. On that day, all students will report to school as usual at 7.30 am in red and white and the school will be dismissed at 10 am. ### 7) *PSLE Oral Examinations*

The PSLE English and Mother Tongue Oral Examination for P6 students will be held on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> August. P6 students will be given separate instructions on their reporting time.

All P1 to P5 students need **not** report to school. Instead, there will be home-based learning for the students on these two days.

### 8) *Edusave Character Award (ECHA) 2017*

Edusave Character Award (ECHA) is given out to recognise students who demonstrate exemplary character and outstanding personal qualities through their behaviour and actions. This is part of the larger goal to foster an inclusive and stronger Singapore as we broaden the qualities and achievements to be encouraged and applauded.

Students must satisfy the following criteria to be eligible for the award:

- i. Student must be a Singaporean;
- ii. Student must demonstrate the GIVER<sup>3</sup>S values (at least 3 values) on a consistent basis;
- iii. Student is concerned about environmental or community issues as a demonstration of civic responsibility; and/or
- iv. Student demonstrates resilience in the face of difficult circumstances and managed to overcome the odds and still do commendably well in academic and non-academic domains.

**Nominations will be open from Tuesday, 1<sup>st</sup> August to Friday, 18<sup>th</sup> August.** Nominations can be submitted by students, school staff and/or parents. The nomination forms are available at the General Office and can also be downloaded from our school website. We encourage parents to put in your nominations for any deserving students you know of.

The ECHA award recipients will receive a certificate and an award voucher. The award quantum is as follows, depending on the level of study:

### 9) *Gifted Education Programme Screening Test*

The Gifted Education Branch of the Curriculum Planning & Development Division will be carrying out the identification of students for the Gifted Education Programme (GEP) 2017. The identification exercise is carried out in two stages – Screening and Selection. The GEP Screening Test will be conducted on Wednesday, 23<sup>rd</sup> August in the school. Shortlisted students at the Screening Stage will be invited to the Selection Stage which will be held on 19<sup>th</sup> October and 20<sup>th</sup> October. The test is open to all Primary 3 students only. A separate letter has been issued to all P3 parents. Parents are to respond by Monday, 7<sup>th</sup> August if you would like your child to sit for the GEP Screening Test. Reply slips are to be returned back to their respective form teachers. We would like to encourage you to allow your child to sit for the Screening Test.
